

PHP and MySQL

3 Day Course

PHP is an open-source server-side scripting language used for the creation of dynamic web pages for e-commerce and other web based applications. As one of the most popular server-side languages commercially used today, PHP offers a simple and universal solution for easy-to-program dynamic web pages.

This three day intensive course will use PhpMyAdmin to administer your own MySQL database and introduce you to the fundamentals of PHP, show you how to build dynamic pages and deal with the basics of secure logins and pages. By using PHP in conjunction with MySQL you will be able to build 'next generation' applications and not simply 'brochure ware'.

This course is based on using a Windows platform, though the skills learnt can be transferred to a Macintosh platform. This course on each day runs from 9.30am to approximately 4.30pm
